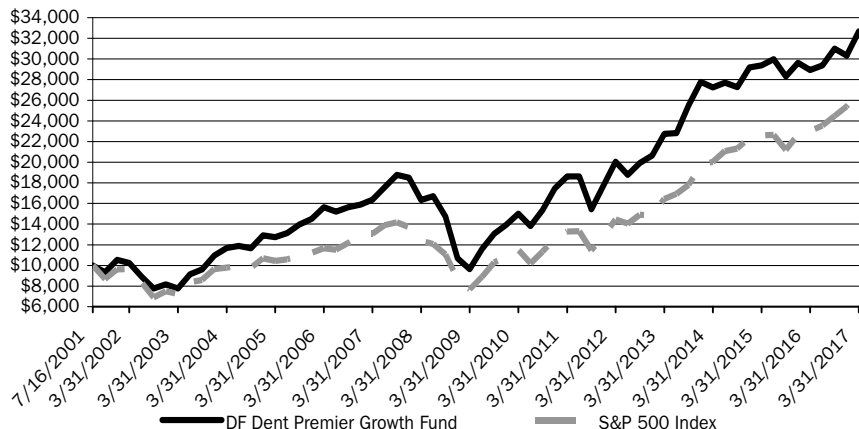

INVESTMENT STRATEGIES

The DF Dent Premier Growth Fund (the "Fund") invests primarily in equity securities of domestic companies that possess superior long-term growth characteristics and that have strong, sustainable earnings prospects and reasonably valued stock prices. The Fund may also invest in companies that do not have particularly strong earnings histories but do have other attributes that may contribute to accelerated growth in the foreseeable future. The Fund primarily invests in medium and large size domestic companies. Medium size companies typically have market capitalizations in the range of \$1.5 billion to \$7 billion. Large companies typically have market capitalizations greater than \$7 billion.

FUND MANAGEMENT

D.F. Dent and Company, Inc. is a registered investment adviser and has provided investment advisory and management services to clients since 1976. As of March 31, 2017, D.F. Dent and Company, Inc. had approximately \$3.92 billion in assets under management. The firm is 100% owned by its nine principals and is unaffiliated with any other investment organization.
